The Centrally Sponsored Programme namely Cluster Promotion Programme (CPP) is one of the important Schemes implemented by CSB in collaboration with State Department. The CPP is a unique and effective tool for transfer of technologies in the field devolved by the research institutes of Central Silk Board during XII Plan. Under this Institute 107 clusters were initiated in southern states and Madhya Pradesh. The details are as follows.
