

## MINUTES ON SPECIAL RAC MEETING CONDUCTED ON 20.11.2023 AT CSRTI, MYSURU TO REVIEW THE CONCLUDED PROJECTS

An on line meeting was conducted under the chairmanship of Prof. M. B. Chetti, Vice Chanchellor, Sanskriri University, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh to review the concluded projects viz., PRP 01015SI, Dr.S.Gandhi Doss, Director, CSRTI, Mysuru welcomed the Chairman, members Prof. Janarthanan, University of Madras; Dr.H. K. Basavaraja, Retd. Director (I/C); Dr.K. Jhansi Lakshmi, Sci-D and Head, RCS and other scientists for the review meeting.

Dr. G.S. Arunkumar, Sci-C, the Principal Investigator of the project “PRP 01015SI Identification, evaluation and inclusion of potential antagonistic microbes in Integrated roo rot disease management in mulberry” presented the concluded project report.

The suggestions given by the Chairman and the Members are as follows:

- Committee appreciated the achievements made in the project including publications.
- Suggested to remove the FYM application and Neem cake application from the cultural practices, as these practices belong to other organic methods in the components of IDM.
- While recommending microbial consortia, it is suggested to mention the concentration of fungicides at which identified microbial consortia are safe.
- Also suggested to prepare separate pouches for bacterial and fungal bio control agents in the consortia.

Dr. Mallikarjun, G Sci-C, the Pricncipal Investigator of the project “AIT 01019SI, Screening of drugs/inhibitors to inhibit the P13k Akt pathway in Bombyx mori for controlling nulear polyhedrosis virus infection” presented the concluded project report.


The suggestions given by the Chairman and the Members are as follows:

- The reeling and silk quality related parameters of the cocoons harvested from the silkworms on which the treatments were oimposed with the identified drug need to be included.
- The function of the upregulated and downregulated transcripts needs to be provided.
- The findings should be published in journals with a high impact factor.
- The benefit: cost ratio of the treatments need to be provided.
